Call to Order of the June 11, 2009, Meeting

Kathy Getz received a letter from Ronald Pavlechko, Secretary/Treasurer for the Mid-State Boys Volleyball League asking her to review the site selection and format for the PIAA "AAA" Sub-regional playoffs among District VI, IX and X. A discussion was held with the District VI Committee members.

The District 6 Committee is reminding principals and athletic directors to have something in place to check the eligibility of athletes on a weekly basis.

Committee members were given a copy of the proposed draft for clearances that will be required for any official that was registered after April 1, 2007. Information will be shared as it becomes available.
